Activities of the project organisation (aims, objectives, actions)	The Pro Gemeinsinn Foundation is a non-profit association, providing Kindergarten education and after school care. Our priority is educating children between 1 and 12 years. We aim to create a positive environment in which the children can thrive, learn, enjoy and grow as human beings as well as feel recognized as important members of society. We hope to also create a good environment for those who share our goals and values and work for and with us. We feel that our work is important for our city and the society we life in as everyone of us has something valuable to contribute. The Association works very closely with the primary school Munchausen, which is one of the few elementary schools, that offers French as mother tongue.	
Description of the community the project is situated in	The project is located in the district of Reinickendorf in the northwest of the city of Berlin with a population of about 263 thousand inhabitants, about 30% of the population have a migratory origin. The family houses predominate in the urban distribution of the district, as well as a wide range of green areas and lakes. Tegel airport is located in this area of Berlin.	
Description of the tasks of the volunteer in the project	The volunteer takes part in the daily activities of the Afterschool-Association and the activities of the primary school, including: Support for teachers in activities in French and German language; work with children, that can be playing games, Toy making, reading, painting, music, sports, singing, etc.; support with the preparation for events and festivals; support children and employees at various other activities. The following learning experiences are made accessible to the volunteer through the intended range of tasks: getting to know the German culture and the German culture Capital as a European metropolis; Getting to know Berlin's (primary) school system, in particular the open	

	All-day operation; learning the German language through the daily contacts with the Children, colleagues and parents; dealing with Children of primary school age and their parents and families; team work in the pedagogical senses and close cooperation with colleagues
Required skills and interests of the volunteer	The Pro Gemeinsinn Foundation has the following expectations towards the volunteer's required skills and interests: - French mother tongue - basic knowledge of German language - enjoy working with children and young people - be open-minded and motivated - be open to work in a responsible, independent way - ability to work in a team - willing to bring in own skills and interests - creative skills
Working hours, working time:	The weekly working hours will be 30-35 hours; two days off a week. Language classes counts as working time.
Training and support for the volunteer	There is a mentor who is responsible for answering any questions and supervising the work of the volunteer, and who speaks English. The volunteer can take part in the regular capacity training for staff members. The project has much experience with German volunteers and has been a host project for the European Voluntary Service for several years now. The volunteer will never work alone, and will never have the sole responsibility for a group of children or young people.
Pocket Money	The volunteer will receive 5 Euro/day as pocket money in monthly payments (paid by ICJA).
Public Transport	The volunteer will be reimbursed for the costs of a monthly public transport ticket (reduced fee) (paid by ICJA)

How will the food arrangement be?	The volunteer will receive a food allowance (amounting to 251Euro/month)
International travel costs	The volunteer will receive a financial contribution to his/her travel costs from his/her place of origin to Germany and back. The amount depends on the distance travelled. For travel distances between 500 km and 1999 km: 275 Euro, between 2000 km and 2999 km: 360 Euro etc.
Insurance	The volunteer will receive health insurance, third party liability insurance as well as general accident insurance via the group insurance of the European Commission (free of charge for the volunteer).
